MANUSCRIPT CHECKLIST

Every manuscript submitted to the Macedonian Veterinary Review must be accompanied by this completed checklist and a signed copyright assignment form.

Any manuscript that is incomplete or improperly set out will be returned to the author without review.

Name of the first author (in block letters)

Article title:

Manuscript

- Manuscript is typed double-spaced (including references, tables, figure legends, and footnotes) on the side only of A4 sized white paper with 2.5 cm margin.
- Standard abbreviations are used in the list provided by the Macedonian Veterinary Review and spelled out in parentheses in its first use in the text.
- Page number is placed at bottom of each page.

Title Page

- Title is concise and informative.
- The authors' names are listed as follows: first name, middle initial(s) and family name, and the institution at which the research was undertaken is included.
- The name, full postal address, telephone and facsimile numbers and E-mail address of the author to whom correspondence is provided.

Abstract

- An unstructured abstract of no more than 250 words is described
- A list of key words (5 words or less) are provided below the abstract using the Medical Subject Headings list from *Index Medicus*.

Body of paper

- Ethical guideline for human or animal study is described.
- Statistical method used is outlined.
- Drugs and chemicals are identified by generic name (if trademarks are mentioned, manufacturer name, city, state, and country are given).

References

- References are cited alphabetical order by the first author's name.
- References are typed double-spaced on sheets separate from the text and numbered consecutively.
- The style and punctuation of the references conform to the recent issue of the Macedonian Veterinary Review.
- Journal titles are abbreviated in accordance with the style of Index Medicus.
- Unpublished observations and personal communications are not listed as references.

Tables

- Tables are typed double-spaced on a separate sheet, accompanied by table number and title above table and explanatory notes below.
- Each table is numbered according to order of citation.

Figure legends

- Legends are typed double-spaced.
- Each figure is numbered according to the order of citation.
- Symbols, arrows, and letters used to indicate parts of illustrations are identified in the legend.

Figures

- All figures are included.
- Illustrations are sharp, glossy prints, no larger than 7.4x10cm.
- Symbol, arrows, and letters are clear and of sufficient size to retain legibility when reduced by 50%.
- Each figure is identified clearly on the back with its number, name of author(s) and arrow indicating orientation.
